It is a huge understatement to say the schools face unbelievable challenges but 2021 has been a particularly difficult year with closures due to Covid restrictions. The travel restrictions meant many families faced starvation. Then Kasese was hit by flooding which swept away many homes and meagre possessions. Accomplish has sent emergency relief aid for flood victims and food knowing the dedicated RAPCD team well and knowing they would move heaven and earth to reach remote families with life saving help. No wonder Maali was so thrilled to receive some extremely good news.

The promised report from Maali has now arrived plus photos of the equipment. Due to the closure of the schools there are as yet no photos of pupils using the equipment. The Ugandan Government have asked for all teachers to be vaccinated before reopening, not easy in such a rural region. Hopefully I will receive some photos next year and then I will send them onto you.
